Life & death in a 20th Century Jewish Shtetl.

BORN: AFTER THE CHMIELNICKI REBELLION OF 1648, A NUMBER OF JEWSH FAMILIES MOVED INTO, A SMALL VILLAGE IN SOUTHERN VOLYN, UKRAINE, CALLED TORCZYN. BY 1765 THE TOWN HAD 640 JEWISH OCCUPANTS.

DIED: ON JUNE 22, 1941 NAZI ARMIES ROLLED INTO THE UKRAINE, AND MOST OF TORCZYN'S **1400** JEWISH RESIDENTS WERE CONFINED IN A GHETTO. AT THE END OF AUGUST 1942 THEY WERE TAKEN TO THE JEWISH CEMETARY AND WERE SHOT AND BURIED. THE TOWNS JEWISH POPULATION WAS NEVER REONSTITUTED. THE BOOK IS A SERIES OF NARRATIVES.

AFTER BAYLA DIED SRACHEEL MARRIED A WOMAN NAMED BOSSIE. MUCH BELOVED, SHE CAME WITH CHILDREN FROM AN EARLIER MARRIAGE. ONE OF HER DAUGHTERS,-SHEINDEL, MARRIED SRACHEEL'S SON-- AARON. .



SRACHEEL'S SECOND SON, SHLOMO MOSHE, LIVED IN THE BUILDING'S SECOND APARTMENT. HIS WIFE WAS CHIA KAILA MEISTER



CHIA'S HALF SISTER, RIFKA JOINED THE TORCZYN FAMILY AFTER HER HUSBAND DIED OF



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TUBERCULOSIS. A SINGLE WOMAN WITH A SMALL INFANT, SHE WALKED TO TORCZYN WITH HER BABY AND ARRIVED SHORTLY BEFORE THE FIRST WORLD WAR. RIFKA AND HER SON MISHA LIVED WITH CHIA KAILA//SHLOMO MOSHE'S FAMILY FOR MANY YEARS. AND MISHA BECAME THE DE-FACTO "YOUNGEST BROTHER." IN THE 1930'S RIFKA MARRIED RAFUEL, THE SON OF SHLOMO'S SISTER, THEY HAD A SON, AND WERE AMONG THE MANY WHO

SISTER, THEY HAD A SON, AND WERE AMONG THE MANY WHO PERISHED IN THE HOLOCAUST.

> THE THIRD SON—ELIYAH LIVED IN ONE OF THE APARTMENTS OF SRACHEEL'S HOUSE. HE HAD 5 (FIVE) DAUGHTERS. TWO MOVED TO ARGENTINA IN THE 1930S AND TWO OF THEIR CHILDREN ESTHER AND JOSE MOVED TO THE U.S. IN THE 1960S. THE REMAINDER OF THE

ELIYAH FAMILY WAS LIVING IN TORCZYN WHEN THE NAZIS INVADED AND WERE AMONG THE MANY WHO WERE MURDERED IN 1942.

ONE OF SRACHEEL'S SONS, AARON, MARRIED BOSSIE'S DAUGHTER, HAD A CHILD, AND WENT TO THE U.S. TO EARN MONEY. YEARS LATER HE RETURNED TO TORCZYN AND TRIED TO MAKE A LIFE, BUT HE DIDN'T SUCCEED. AFTER A FEW YEARS IN THE RUSSIAN SHTETL AARON RETURNED TO AMERICA. THIS TIME HE BROUGHT HIS FAMILY AND TOOK SHLOMO'S OLDEST SON—DAVE--WITH HIM

ONE DAUGHTER RACHEL (EHRLICH) MARRIED A MAN FROM THE NEARBY TOWN OF ROZHYSHE. THEIR SON ZEV EHRLICH MOVED TO TURKISH PALESTINE. ZEV'S SON, RACHEL'S GRANDSON, IS AHOUVIA EHRLICH. HE LIVES IN AVICHAIL, A MOSHAV IN ISRAEL

> ONE OF SRACHEEL'S DAUGHTERS, LEAH MARRIED AND STAYED IN TORCHIN. HER SON RAFUEL MARRIED RIFKA, MISHA'S WIDOWED MOTHER.

SHLOMO MOSHE AND KAILA HAD 4 SONS: DAVE (DOVID), HARRY (USHER), NEIL (SHMEIL) AND MANUEL (MENDEL). AND TWO DAUGHTERS: SURCA AND FAY. BETWEEN 1900 AND 1939 ALL MANAGED TO MOVE TO THE U.S.

THE SCENE SHIFTS TO AMERICA DURING THE WAR YEARS AND AFTER THE WAR. TWO OF SHLOMO MOSHE'S SONS, DAVE AND HARRY, NOW LIVED IN AMERICA. THEY WORKED, MARRIED, HAD CHILDREN, AND WHEN POSSIBLE SENT MONEY AND HELPED BRING THE REST OF THE FAMILY TO THE U.S.

AFTER THE FIRST WORLD WAR THE WESTERN UKRAINE BECAME PART OF A NEW COUNTRY CALLED POLAND AND TORCHIN BECAME A POLISH SHTETL.

SHLOMO MOSHE'S NUMBER 2 SON, HARRY (USHER), VISITED THE FAMILY IN EUROPE.

ONE BY ONE MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY EMIGRATED TO THE NEW WORLD: NEIL, MANUEL, SURCA, FAVISH, CHIA KAILA, AND FAY EACH HAD A UNIQUE IMMIGRANT EXPERIENCE. AFTER HE CAME TO THE U.S., BROTHER NEIL MARRIED CLARA, A POLISH TRANSPLANT WITH A UNIQUE STORY.

MISHA, THE COUSIN WHO WAS PART OF THE FERDMAN FAMILY REMAINED IN TORCYN AND BECAME A RADICAL ZONIST.

IN 1939 THE RUSSIANS OCCUPIED THE UKRAINE AND TORCZYN BECAME A RUSSIAN VILLAGE.



MISHA--A POLITICAL ACTIVIST- BECAME A MARKED MAN. HE ESCAPED TO LITHUANIA, BUT WAS UNABLE TO GO FURTHER. HIS LIFE WAS ULTIMATELY SAVED BY THE JAPANESE STATESMAN CHIUNE SUGIHARA. MISHA THEN SPENT THE SECOND WORLD WAR IN SHANGHAI..



IN 1941 THE NAZIS INVADED RUSSIA,. MOST OF TORCZYN'S JEWS WERE TRAPPED AND MASSACRED, BUT A FEW.SURVIVED AND WERE ABLE TO TELL THE STORY OF THE SHTETL'S FINAL DAYS. ONE OF THE SURVIVORS WAS HIDDEN A UKRANIAN FAMILY. (PHOTO LEFT)



50 MILES WEST OF TORCYN A JEWISH FAMILY IN THE TOWN OF VOLODYMYR VOLYNSKY MANAGED TO SURVIVE. THEIR SONS EVENTUALLY CAME TO THE US
