

Manuel's travels

The late August **1930 Dominican Republic Hurricane** was the fifth **deadliest Atlantic hurricane** on record: 50,000 to 100,000 persons were homeless and the whole population was in dire need of food and medical supplies

Manuel's -- Dominican passport was issued on December 13, 1930

April 17, 1931 Manuel arrived in Miami by air from Santa Domingo.

A year later, on June 5, 1932 Sydine and Manuel married.

6 weeks later on July 22, 1932, Manuel Crossed from Detroit into Windsor Ontario (alone).

On August 22, 1932 - he obtained a visa to travel from Havana to Santo Domingo, and on Sept 4, 1932 – Manuel departed to Havana Cuba by ship (alone)

Two days later, on Sept 6, 1932 - he returned from Havana Cuba to Key West (alone).

According to Ronnie Reisler, Sydine was concerned when Manuel left in July 1932, the month after the wedding, and didn't come back for while. She told Ron that she wasn't entirely sure if he was going to come back. And “she wasn't sure that the marriage was going to work out. “
